The maintenance team has been busy getting ready for the winter season.

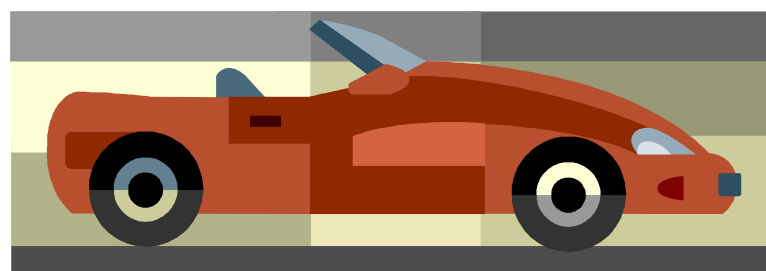
- The holiday decorations are out, the snow equipment is ready and the salt sheds are full.
