Safety Update:

Fireworks during the Fourth of July are as American as apple-pie, but did you know that more fires are reported on that day than any other day of the year in the United States? More than half of these fires are caused by fireworks. The good news is you can enjoy your holiday and the fireworks, with just a few simple safety tips:

PROCEED WITH CAUTION!

Leave fireworks to the professionals.

Do not use consumer fireworks.

The safest way to enjoy fireworks is to attend a public display conducted by trained professionals.

After the firework display, children should never pick up fireworks that may be left over, they may still be active.

How **HOT** does a sparkler burn?

Consumer fireworks include sparklers and firecrackers. The tip of a sparkler burns at a temperature of more than **1,200 degrees Fahrenheit**, which is hot enough to cause third-degree burns.

FACTS Each July Fourth, thousands of people, most often children and teens, are injured while using consumer fireworks. The risk of fireworks injury was two-and-a-half times as high for children ages 10–14 as for the general population.

Maintenance Update:

New this spring! A fire pit area down at the activities area. The new attraction will have paver walk and seating area, benches and a large fire pit for having outdoor activities. The work will be landscaped with bushes and plants, graded out and completed in the next few weeks.

We have been digging around in repairs lately and we have had to repair a leak down by the activities area a few weeks ago and another in the campground road intersection this week. **We would like to thank everyone for their patience as we did these much needed repairs.**

Hanging baskets are up and some new items have been added around the resort. There are a few added baskets for each of the areas and entry ways throughout the resort in an effort to give it a little more pop of color as we visit each location.

Weather has slowed the process up for all of the planting activities. The rain and cold weather has delayed many of the plants getting in the ground and being complete by the time Memorial day arrived. We are working diligently to finish the work here early in June. We have been also putting in mulch and cleaning all the beds out on property.

Tree trimming will begin in June as we start to remove dead trees around the property. We will be doing this through a service that can cleanly and carefully extract the trees from the locations. They will start as soon as they return from their work in northern Wisconsin where the tornadoes went through.

Housekeeping Update:

In May Resort Housekeeping did 403 work orders and SSC cleaned 2062 units.

Ski Update:

Recently we added 3 new runs to the ski hill bringing our count to 16 total runs. We have also added vertical drop and length to the tubing park, in hopes of increasing our mid-week group business. We are also improving efficiency on the west side of the ski hill by upgrading our electrical and improving our lighting on the west side of the hill.
