

CHRISTMAS MOUNTAIN SANITARY DISTRICT

Christmas Mountain Sanitary District is organized under Section 60.70 of the State of Wisconsin Statutes and constitutes a separate and distinct municipality. The district is designed to be a self-supporting entity, deriving its revenue from sewer user and standby fees. Rates for the sewer utility are set by the board of commissioners. The district provides sewer service to properties within the district boundaries in Dellona Township. In 2010, the district served an average of 122 residential customers, 4 associations and 4 retail departments at Christmas Mountain.

Board of Commissioner's meetings are held quarterly and are open to the public unless posted as closed meetings.

SEWER FEES

Sewer fees are billed on a quarterly basis and are currently (as of Jan 1, 2012) billed at \$117.75/qtr. for one REU (Residential Equivalency Unit).

Tap-in fees are charged when application for tap-in is made for a new home to be connected to the sewer main at the rate of \$3,000 plus \$250 inspection fee. An application for tap-in services must be submitted to the Operations Manager prior to receiving services. Application forms are available at the Accounting Coordinator's office located in the Employment Services Building.

Buildable lot fees (standby fees) are charged to an owner of a lot that is vacant in the amount of .33 of the annual sewer fee user rate. The lot fee will be billed to each owner on a semi-annual basis on January 1 and July 1 for a total of \$155.44 for the calendar year.
